

## TEACHER TRAINING

Richard and Linda Goddard conduct this 10-hour training event. Participants for the training are those within the congregation that have an interest in teaching one of the "Just Say Know"® courses. It is a requirement that at least one member of the ministerial staff attend this training so any theological concerns can be addressed.

It is recommended that more than one church participate in the training. Most mainline denominations have participated in the Just Say Know® programs and could be included in a community-wide training. This is a wonderful way to build relationships between different denominations within the community. Some churches also utilize the "Just Say Know" program as an outreach tool in their community to youth who do not have a church home. The cost of the **10-hour training event is \$800 plus transportation, motel, and meals for the trainers.**

The training will consist of taking participants through the 10-session high school sexuality course. Having completed this training, participants will be qualified, with the help of CLER Ministries' resources, to conduct elementary through adult classes at their respective churches and each participant will receive a Certificate of Completion from CLER Ministries.

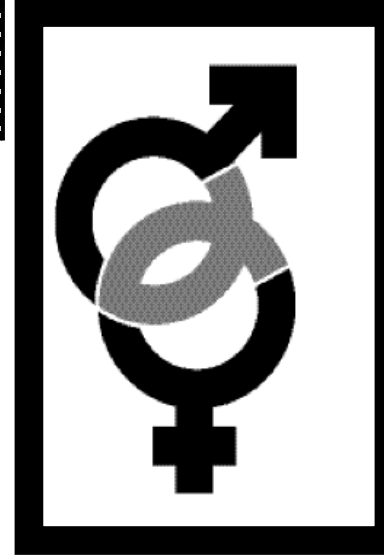

## ELEMENTARY

Workshops on Preparing for Adolescence for Elementary Boys/Parents  
Elementary Girls/Parents

Workshop for 4th-5th grade girls and parents is 3 hours in length. Workshop for 4th-5th grade boys and parents is 2-1/2 hours in length. Presentations cover the physical and emotional changes that occur during adolescence, male and female reproductive anatomies, menstruation, wet dreams, sexual intercourse, conception, HIV/AIDS, and sexual abuse. Rules for Internet usage and adolescent dating expectations are discussed. Spiritual focus is God's marvelous design of the male/female, and God's plan for sexual intimacy as a gift to be enjoyed in marriage.

## MIDDLE SCHOOL

This 6-hour workshop is designed to enhance communication between parents and youth as it outlines God's plan for sexual intimacy in a committed marital relationship. Topics covered are male and female reproductive anatomies, emotional and physical changes, peer pressure, dating pitfalls, contraceptives, STIs and HIV/AIDS.

## HIGH SCHOOL

"AND GOD CREATED THEM MALE AND FEMALE..." AND NOW WHAT?!  
A Human Sexuality Study for High School Youth

This 10-session Biblically-based sexuality and relationship study enables youth to think through the complex and life-changing decisions they will face in this area. Some of the subjects covered include male and female anatomies, masturbation, sexual intimacy, teen parenting, abortion, adoption, contraception, STI/AIDS, abstinence, sexual addictions, sexual orientations, dating, dating violence, harassment, breaking up, falling in love, divorce, and commitment in marriage.

"THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE"  
A Study for Adults of Human Sexuality and the Marriage Covenant

## ADULT

This 15-session study of sexuality, mid-life transition, divorce, and strengthening the marriage covenant is designed to help parents become the sexuality educators of their children and to enhance marriage relationships. Education about sexuality issues such as sexual orientations and addictions are also presented.

## "CREATED TO BE ME" CAMP

"FEARFULLY AND WONDERFULLY MADE!"  
Sexuality Education Program for Ninth Grade Youth

This one-week summer camping program provides soon-to-be-ninth grade youth with factual and spiritual sexuality information that will help them view sexual intimacy as a gift from God intended for the marriage relationship. It will enlighten youth to the risks and consequences that can occur when God's gift is used outside of marriage.

Campers receive keynote addresses each morning focusing on the humanity of Jesus, God's love, forgiveness, and plan for their lives. Campers attend small group sessions twice a day for related activities and fellowship. Workshops on anatomy, puberty, conception, STIs/AIDS, contraception, abstinence, dating pitfalls and abusive relationships are presented in the evenings.

Youth design and participate in evening worship services that reflect the keynote topic for the day. The usual fun camping activities like crafts, games, dance, swimming, and fellowship are all part of this very special and unique camping experience.
